## Reflection and Discussion Questions

### Looking backward

### Looking upward

  - Do you tend to pray for more wants or needs? Why?
  - What difference would it make for you to pray for needs instead of wants?
- Read the following passages: Deuteronomy 8 & James 4:13-17.
  - What do these verses teach us about our dependence on God?
  - How do these verses help you understand this petition better?
- In the sermon, David mentioned that praying for daily bread is praying for "all of us." How can you pray this prayer with integrity? What will you do to be used by God to provide for the needs of others?

### Looking forward

- What does it look like for you to apply this passage in your life? Spend time reflecting, sharing & praying to God for him to enable you to apply the truth of the message.
- Who can you share what you learned with? Do you have any non-Christian friends who needs to hear the truth of this message? If you have children, how can you help your child to learn what you learned this week?
